League: 2 Person Teams
Handicap Match Play
22 Points per Match (20 Individual and 2 Team)
Max Handicap - 18

- Present Team member can play as sub(2 times per team for each season half) thereafter
Absent Player will be a Forfeit
Will draw a random score card for the present player to play against.
Absent Player receives no points and his team is not eligible for the team points.
- Absent Team, a random drawn score card will be used for the present team to play against.
Absent Team receives no points.
- Must play opponent head-to-head. No matching of score cards.
- Sub can not play for both team players

Handicap: Handicaps are calculated using Equitable Stroke Control at a 90% factor on 50% of league played rounds (best rounds) rounded. The 2011 handicap will be calculated using the 2011 league rounds starting with week 1. Subs handicaps will be calculated using the 2011 league posted rounds.

Scoring: Two-person league
Individual Points - Maximum individual points is 10 points
Low Net for Each Hole 1 point per hole
Low Net for Match 1 point.
Team Points - Low Team Net 2 point
Total points for Match – 22 points

The lowest handicap players are matched for the individual hole competition. The other two players are then matched for the individual hole competition. Handicaps are applied on a hole by hole basis starting with the hardest hole first.
